 3. Group 1 and 2 are split, so **make sure you know which group you belong to.**
 4. **Smile** – interact with the kids if they are there!

Group 2: (*Loudly*) Strike the harp and join the chorus, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la

Everyone: Follow me in merry measure, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la

While I tell of Yule-tide treasure, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la

Group 1: Fast away the old year passes, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la
